### Sparkling

NV Adame Garbel Prosecco Treviso, Italy 11.0

*A crisp, dry Prosecco from one of Italy's highest regarded producers. Displaying a fine consistent bead, with aromas of brioche and a palate of well integrated acid and fruit sweetness.*

### White

2009 Ten Minutes by Tractor Barrel Fermented Sauvignon Blanc , Main Ridge, Victoria 10.0

*From the Mornington Peninsula's highly acclaimed Ten Minutes by Tractor, a Sauvignon Blanc that is racey and crisp, yet eschews the body and character that comes only from producers such as these.*

2010 Stefano Lubiana 'Primavera' Chardonnay Granton, Tasmania 11.0

*From Granton, on the Derwent River, Stphano Lubuiana has become renowned for their uncompromising quality. Their 'Primavera' Chardonnay exhibits a flinty nose, with a broader palate of honey dew and restrained oak.*

2008 E. Knoll Gruner Veltliner Federspiel Wachau, Austria 14.0

*A Gruner Veltliner produced by Austria's Emerich Knoll. An exceptional white wine displaying restraint and balance. A luscious palate of citrus and white peach, with a lingering peppery finish.*

2008 Moorilla Estate 'Muse' Series Riesling Hobart, Tasmania 11.0

*Moorilla's benchmark white, a powerful and alluring Riesling, with notes of lemon and orange peel , and a palate consisting of a strong backbone of acid, well integrated with luscious lemon curd.*

2007 Renato Ratti Dolcetto D'Alba Piedmont, Italy 16.0

*Renato Ratti was one of the pioneers of Italy's acclaimed appellation system, and brought forward the quality of Italys wine to the international market. Floral bouquet of violets, with a palate of ripe fruit, smooth tannins and restrained acid.*

2009 Evesham Wood 'Willamette Valley' Pinot Noir Oregon, USA 15.0

*A deadly serious wine from a proven winemaker, this Pinot Noir is true to the varietal and terroir. Delicate yet deep and brooding. Fine rounded tannins accompany a palate of ripe cherry, raspberry and mushroom. Our pick of the month.*

2009 Les Remejeanne 'Les Chevrefeuilles' Cotes du Rhone, France 15.0

*This Rhone Blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourevèdre, Carignan, Cinsaut and Counoise exhibits the dark, rich and voluptuous red wines Rhone is renoned for. Black fruit, spice and smoke on the nose, with a herbal, floral palate with pronounced tannins and acid structure.*

2008 Pittnaur Blaufrankisch Klassic Burgenland, Austria 11.0

*Pittnaur is one of Austria's leading wineries, drawing international acclaim. The Grape Blaufrankisch, as displayed in this wine, is a medium bodied red wine, with a subtle herbal cross floral nose, delicate ripe fruit and apparent tannins.*

### Sweet

2009 Zibibbo Moscato d'Alessandria Sicily, Italy 11.0

*This still sweet wine from Sicily is made from an indigenous varietal called Moscato d'Alessandria. Sweet but not cloying due to its acid and alcohol balance. Aromas of honey and rasin, with a plump palate of peach and lemon curd.*
